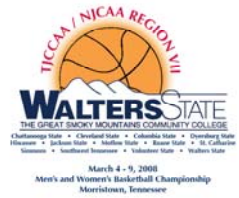

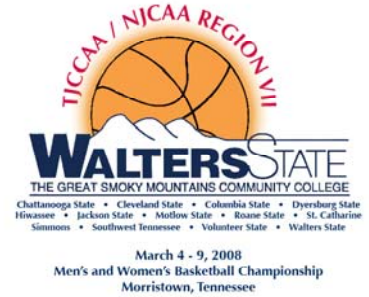

- **Tickets and Admission**

Ticket prices for the 2008 TJCCAA / NJCAA Region VII Tournament will be \$7.00 per day. A tournament ticket for the entire event will be \$20.00. Children under the age of 12 will be admitted free. There will be two gates: one for the general public and one “pass” gate. The gates are in the Walters State Jack E. Campbell College Center Building. The “Pass” gate is located on the west side (see map), and the gate for the “General Public” is at the front entrance (see map). Campus police will be on site to help direct you to the parking areas.

- **College Passes**

Each institution will be given 20 passes for each team in the tournament. Each institution will also be given 10 passes to the hospitality room. These will be for coaches, college administrators, etc. The passes will be in the coach’s packet that can be picked up before the tournament. (Make sure that the passes are treated with respect, and assigned to only one person). If you need additional passes, please contact Foster Chason, Tournament Director.

- **College Coaches**

Coaches from recruiting colleges may purchase a special tournament ticket for \$15.00, which will include a ticket to all tournament games, a hospitality room pass and a tournament program.

- **Publicity**

The Lon Price Room in the College Center will serve as the Media Room for all tournament activities. A Fax machine, telephone, computer and an interview area for coaches and players will be available. Please have your media contact Brian Trent for assistance. We will provide special access for wireless internet (on request to Joe Combs). Our Public Relations Department will keep the tournament website up-to-date after each game throughout the tournament (www.tjccaasports.com). Stat sheets for each game will be located in the media room. For media passes, contact Brian Trent at 423-736-0849.

- **Programs**

Each institution will receive 20 tournament programs for each team prior to the tournament. The programs will be in the coach’s packet that will be available prior to the tournament. Programs will also be sold in the main lobby of the College Center for \$5.00.

- **T-Shirts**

Tournament T-shirts will also be on sale in the lobby of the College Center. The T-shirts will sell for \$10.00 each. If you would like to reserve t-shirts for your team, please contact Foster Chason with the number of t-shirts needed and the sizes you want. They will be ready for you when you pick up your packet prior to the tournament.

- **Roster and Photograph**

Each team must send an official NJCAA roster form and photograph for the program. The roster must be filled out completely and the picture must comply with NJCAA standards. The photo must be at least 5X7 black and white or color with a glossy finish. Numbers of players must be showing. You can send the

photo electronically or by hard copy. These must be sent by February 1, 2008 in order to get the program printed. This is very important because the rosters and photos will be sent by the NJCAA Region VII Directors for the National Tournament.

- **Tournament Breakfast**

The tournament breakfast and meeting will be on Wednesday, March 5, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. in the Duggins Foundation room on the Walters State Campus. The breakfast will be for coaches, athletic directors and college administrators. Please contact Commissioner L. Quentin Lane with any agenda items you would like addressed.

- **Videotaping and Radio Broadcasts**

There will be a videotaping area on the upper level of the gym opposite the benches for the teams playing in each particular game. A place will be available for each team. Teams will only be permitted to videotape the games in which they are participating. Please contact Joe Combs, Assistant Tournament Director if you have any special requests. All radio broadcasts will be operating on the upper level of the gym opposite the benches of the teams. Please contact Joe Combs at joseph.combs@ws.edu prior to the tournament for information.

- **Athletic Trainer**

Walters State Community College will have a Certified Athletic Trainer on site during the tournament. Matthew Barnes will coordinate with the team trainers. Please contact Foster Chason with questions at (423) 585.2680.

- **Game Floor Clean-up**

The gym floor will be swept at the beginning of the half-time for each game. Please stay off of the playing floor until it is completed.

- **Game Protocol**

Teams on the top of the bracket will wear white and be on the scoreboard as the home team. Please have both uniforms available in case there is a mix-up. Home team will sit on the bench to the right as you face the scorers table. Teams will have a 20-minute pre-game warm-up. Teams will not be allowed to warm-up/shoot at half time of a previous game. Please be courteous and keep your team off of the basketball court until it is your time and leave promptly once your time is up.

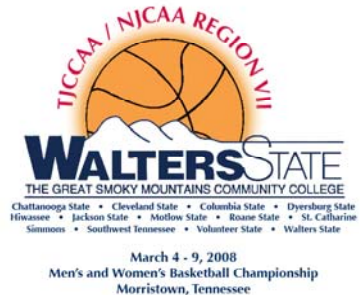
- **Awards**

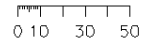
